As a College Student, can I only vote in my hometown?

You can vote
EITHER in you
hometown, or the
current place of
residence, but you
cannot register in
both locations.



What if I do not have a Texas Photo ID?

No problem!
You do not need
an ID to register
to vote. You can
register with a
social security
card.

OR you can check
the box indicating
that you currently
do not have an ID
