Registering to Vote as a College Student

As a College Student, can I only vote in my hometown?

You can vote **EITHER** in you hometown, or the current place of residence, but you cannot register in both locations.



What if I do not have a Texas Photo ID?

No problem! You do not need an ID to register register with a social security card.

OR you can check the box indicating that you currently to vote. You can do not have an ID


