Duties of a Volunteer Deputy Registrar

1. Offer a Voter Registration Application to any Travis County resident.
2. Assist each person completing the application, and answer any questions they have.
3. Review the signed and completed application. Be sure to correct any errors or obtain missing information.
4. Complete the receipt at the bottom of the form and give it to the applicant. Suggest they keep the receipt until receiving their certificate in the mail.
5. Inform the applicant that their registration status will be effective 30 days from the date of registration, and certificates are mailed monthly.

Submit all Yellow VDR forms in person within 5 days to one of the Voter Registration offices listed below.

The Voter Registration Application: REQUIRED FIELDS

Below is a copy of the Voter Registration Application. Filling out each field is preferred.

However, the Secretary State requires the completion of the highlighted fields below in order to accept the application as complete.

Please use the guide below to ensure that all applications are complete before issuing a receipt.

1. CITIZENSHIP QUESTION:

The applicant must check either yes or no.

2. LAST NAME/FIRST NAME:

All applicants must register with their legal name as Stated on a Government Issued ID.

3. RESIDENCE ADDRESS:

This address indicates where a person lives. The applicant must provide an address to register in a Travis County precinct.

A PO Box or Rural Route number is not acceptable for the residence, but can be used as a mailing address.

If the mailing address is the same as the residential address, they may leave #4 blank.

6. DATE OF BIRTH:

Date of birth must include the month, day and year the applicant was born.
